

Privacy Policy for Drone Usage

Denham-Blythe operates an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) drone to provide our clients with aerial imagery and 3D terrain models for pre-construction and as-built site topography. All drones used at Denham-Blythe are registered with the FAA and all drone operators are certified FAA airmen.

Collection and Disclosure of Information

Data taken by our drones is used specifically for sharing with each individual client only. No data taken by drones will be shared with any third party not directly involved in company operations. Once the aerial imagery and/or 3D terrain model is provided to our clients, responsibility for maintaining compliance with our privacy policy also transfers to the client.

Storage of Information/Data

Denham-Blythe stores all personal information and data collected by drones on private hard drives and is typically transferred to clients via physical transfer of portable storage devices or email. No data is stored on public domains and we take all the necessary precautions to ensure that any data collected is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.
